# 2019 e-ICON World Contest Guidelines


## 1. Background

- To nurture global next-generation e-Learning human resources by providing both domestic and international students a chance to engage in international cooperation activities
- To develop e-Learning contents that are utilizable in the international education environment by forming a multi-national group, promoting social and cultural understanding

## 2. Overview

- **Title:** The 9th e-ICON World Contest [e-learning International Contest of Outstanding New Ages]
- **Date:** August 18 (Sun.) – August 24 (Sat.), 2019 (7 days)
- **Venue:** Hanwha Resort, Busan, Republic of Korea
- **Host:** Ministry of Education (MOE), Republic of Korea
- **Organizer:** Institute of APEC Collaborative Education (IACE)
- **Sponsors**
  - **Overseas:** Education ministries and related organizations of participating countries
  - **Domestic (ROK)**
    - Pusan National University Software Education Center
    - 17 Provincial Offices of Education
    - APEC Learning Community Builders-Entrepreneur Committee (ALCoB-EC)
- **Participants:** approx. 100 contestants
  - **Overseas:** 12 advisory teachers, 26 high school and vocational high school students  
(1 team nominated by each nation; each team composes of one teacher and two students)
  - **Domestic (ROK):** 21 advisory teachers, 42 high school and vocational high school students  
(Each team composes of one teacher and two students)
  - ※ Teachers should apply along with a pair of students and will play a leading role as advisors
  - **Global group building:** 1 overseas team & 1 Korean team to make up a global group

### 4. Main Contents

- **Outline:** Form 21 global groups through the recommendation of youth by Korean & overseas educational institutions, who have distinguished capabilities in e-learning; engage in collaborative development activities on application development as well as its competition
- **Pre-program Activity(Online):** Receiving basic online education, including educational ICT; draft an e-learning application development proposal, and make initial version through team communication platform(Google drive)
- **On-site Activity:** Revise and supplement e-learning materials developed throughout the Pre-program activity through collaborating with team members, and come up with measures to apply them into real-world situations
  - ※ Date/Venue: August 19-23, 2019 (excluding arrival, departure day) / Hanhwa Resort, Busan, ROK
- **Post-program Activity(Online):** Each team makes presentation on their creative content; an outstanding team is selected as a result of evaluation; exhibit their work during Edu-tech Fair 2019; exhibitions and demonstrations are held for the general public audience
  - ※ Edu-tech Fair (2019): End of September 2019/ COEX (Seoul, Korea) (tentative)

## 6. Guidelines for Participating in the Event

- **Participants:** Approx. 100 participants
  - **Overseas:** 13 teams (1 team nominated by each country; each team composes of one teacher and two students)
  - **Domestic (Korea):** 21 teams (Each team composes of one teacher and two students)
  - ※ 13 Global groups: 1 overseas team & 1 Korean team to make up a global group
  - ※ Two advisory teachers (1 Korean +1 Overseas) will oversee individual global groups
  - ※ For 4 teams composing of only Korean ones, two (2) Korean teachers would oversee their groups
- **Eligibility**
  - **The target contestants of e-ICON this year is confined only to high school students**
  - Each participant must receive prior consent and submit a recommendation letter from the principal of his/her school.
  - Students who have received awards in ICT-related contests or those with an equivalent ability are more than welcomed to participate.
  - ※ At least one of the team members should be proficient in verbal and written English.
  - ※ Students from vocational high schools with content development skills are more than welcomed to join in.
- **Procedures for selecting participants**
  - (Stage 1) **Receive application from students:** Receipt of application forms to relevant Ministries or Institutes (**Overseas**→**Ministry of Education in each country**; **ROK**→**organizer, IACE**)
  - (Stage 2) **Screen and Nominate 1 team from each country:** For overseas participants, 1 team will be nominated by the Ministry of Education of each participating country; ROK participants are screened by the organizer, IACE
  - ※ Each country is requested to express its willingness to participate in the 9<sup>th</sup> e-ICON World Contest no later than **May 31 Friday**
  - ※ After expressing the willingness, each country is requested to send an application of a team by **June 7 Friday**, to the concerned staff (Myungsun Park (Mr.), [pms@alcob.org](mailto:pms@alcob.org), +82-70-4640-1206)
  - (Stage 3) **Confirmation & announcement of final participants**
  - ※ Official notifications will be sent to each participant and posted on the official e-ICON website ([www.alcob.org](http://www.alcob.org))



## 7. Guidelines for Participating in the Event (Continued)

- Participant Recommendation Letter, Application Form for teachers and students, Written Oath Form, Participant Proposal Form (one copy each)

- Android environment must be the basis for the application development operation

## 8. Stipulations and Notes for Applicants

### ○ Copyright for the final application

- The copyright of all entries is held by the organizers and the organizers have the right to adjust the work to other forms
- Contestants are liable for any legal disputes raised by the copyright holder in the case of improper conduct in exploiting the copyright without the consent from the copyright owner; thus, prior consultation with the owner of the content that will be used as part of the application is strongly recommended

## 9. Support for nominated contestants

### ○ Travel expenses and accommodation

- Round-trip flight tickets from/to the capital city of each participating country to/from the adjacent domestic airport in Korea

- Accommodation during the contest (2 or 3 participants share a room)

### ○ Meals and Snacks

- Meals are provided by IACE (3 times a day)

- Snacks are also provided by IACE
